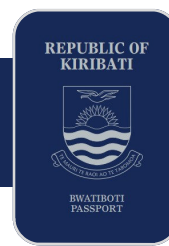

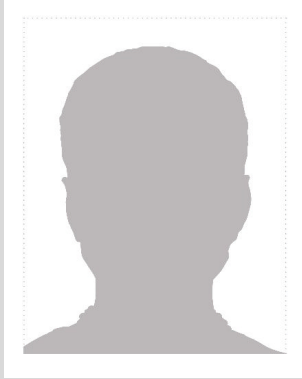
Instructions

The address must be a street address, not a Post Office box number. There is an additional fee for this service.

I. Endorsement (application for official passport only)

Instructions

An application for an official passport must be endorsed by the senior officer of the applicant's organisation. For a magistrate or officer of the High Court, this will be the Chief Registrar. For an officer of the Maneaba ni Maungatabu, this will be the Clerk to the Maneaba. For an officer of the Kiribati National Audit Office, this will be the Auditor General. For an officer of the Kiribati Police Service, this will be the Commissioner of Police. For a person employed in the public service, this will be the applicant's Secretary. For a mayor of a local government council, this will be the Secretary of the Ministry responsible for local government. For a Chief Executive Officer of a statutory corporation or government-owned company, this will be the Secretary of the responsible Ministry. For a person employed by an international governmental organisation, this will be the Secretary to the Cabinet. An endorsement is not required for an application from a person who is a Judge, a Secretary, the Chief Registrar, the Clerk to the Maneaba, the Auditor General or the Commissioner of Police.

Instructions

- I understand that, if I have given misleading information, the application may be refused, or the passport may later be cancelled, and that I can, by law, be fined or imprisoned.
- I understand that use or possession of a forged or false Kiribati travel document is a very serious offence, punishable by imprisonment for up to 10 years, a fine of up to \$20,000, or both.
- I understand that a Kiribati passport remains the property of the Republic at all times.
- I authorise the Secretary for Foreign Affairs and Immigration to make any enquiries the Secretary considers necessary concerning my application for a passport.
